



HEAVY INFESTATION OF LEAF CUTTER BEES ON THE LEAVES OF GOLDEN SHOWER PLANT, CASSIA FISTULA IN AND AROUND SOLAPUR CITY OF MAHARASHTRA STATE

ABSTRACT: The present study reports infestation of leaf cutter bees to the leaves of *Cassia fistula* in and around Solapur City of Maharashtra State. Three species of leaf cutter bees were associated. These bees belong to the genus *Meghachile* and all bees preferred tender and succulent leaves (85%) on all the plants. The maximum frequency of visits of the bees was in the morning and evening and very few during afternoon session.
