ABSTRACT: The whitefly genus *Martiniella* is reviewed and two new species under the genus from south India are described and illustrated. Four species of *Aleuroclava* viz., *A. baccaureae* (Corbett), *A. fici* (Corbett), *A. sepangensis* Martin and Mound and *A. srilankaensis* (David) have been assigned to *Martiniella* proposing new combinations. A key to the puparia of the species of *Martiniella* is given.
